



“Snow Angel” - Snow Shoveling Volunteer

Overview: Volunteer will make a connection with an older homeowner by taking care of their snow removal. Snow removal is done when it snows 2 inches or more. Volunteers are asked to remove snow within a 24 hour timeframe.

Service Impact: The DARTS snow shoveling volunteer plays a crucial part in helping older adults remain independent in their own homes, by providing a service that is either difficult or impossible for them to manage on their own. Keeping their sidewalks and driveways free from snow and ice, helps them get safely to their vehicles or mailbox and allows other service providers easy access to their homes.

Key Responsibilities:

- Shovel (or use a snow blower) to remove snow from sidewalks, steps and the driveway within 24 hours after a 2” snowfall has stopped falling. This includes weekdays and weekends.
- Greet the homeowner at the door each time the service is provided.
- Follow DARTS safety rules and volunteer guidelines.
- Report volunteer hours each time by calling 651-234-2287, or by sending an e-mail to the Volunteer Manager.
- Notify Outdoor chore number or Volunteer Resources if unavailable to remove snow.

Time Commitment: 1-2 hours each time a 2” or greater snowfall occurs.

A desire to work outdoors

Over the age of 16 if operating a snow blower

Reliable transportation
