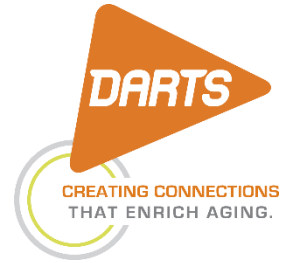


# Caregiver Support Group Options
