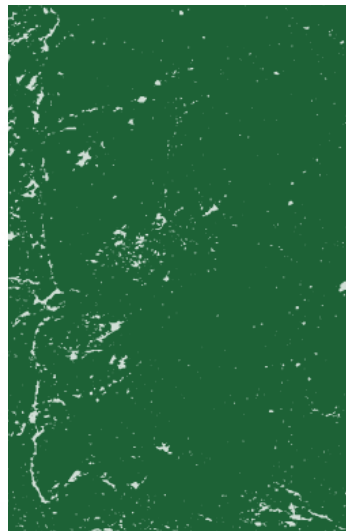
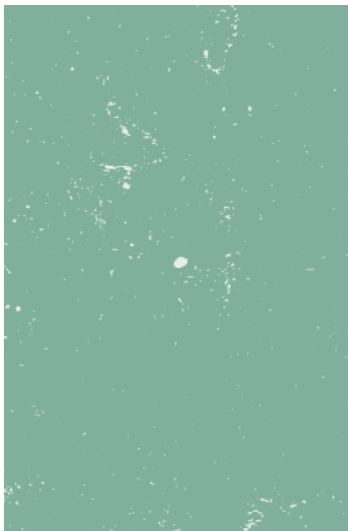

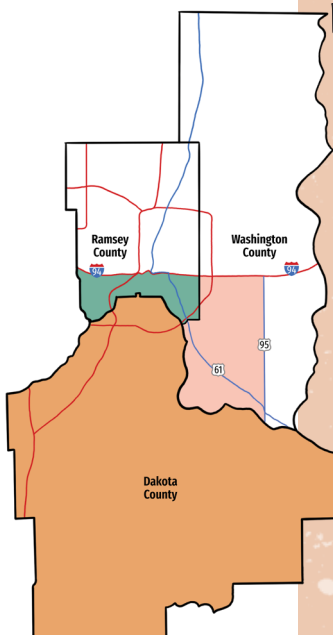
Healthy Aging Specialists connect residents to services supporting independent living. **DARTS provides assistance in 17 senior apartment buildings, nearly doubling since 2023.** In 2025, we are increasing onsite presence and providing Tech Buddy support and Dementia education.

Increased Reach

In 2025, we will continue to expand our impact by offering home services in southern Ramsey County. At the same time, we will deepen our engagement with the LGBTQ+ community, the Latine community, and other underserved populations, **ensuring more people have access to vital resources and meaningful connections.**



Guided by a dedicated and forward-thinking leadership team, DARTS remains committed to creating a prepared and fearless aging journey for everyone. Our steadfast dedication to healthy aging will continue under the leadership of our new President.

Intergenerational Connections

The Learning Buddies & Pen Pals programs are growing, extending into southern Washington County and adding new classrooms! Older-adult volunteers engage with students, building intergenerational connections and strengthening community ties. **In 2024, 170 volunteers supported nearly 2,400 students in 106 classrooms.**

Funding

Uncertain federal funding for Medicaid and the Older Americans Act puts access to services at risk for nearly 300 DARTS clients. To ensure continued programs, we must bridge a potential \$300,000 gap in 2025. **We need your support to keep essential services available to those who need them the most.**

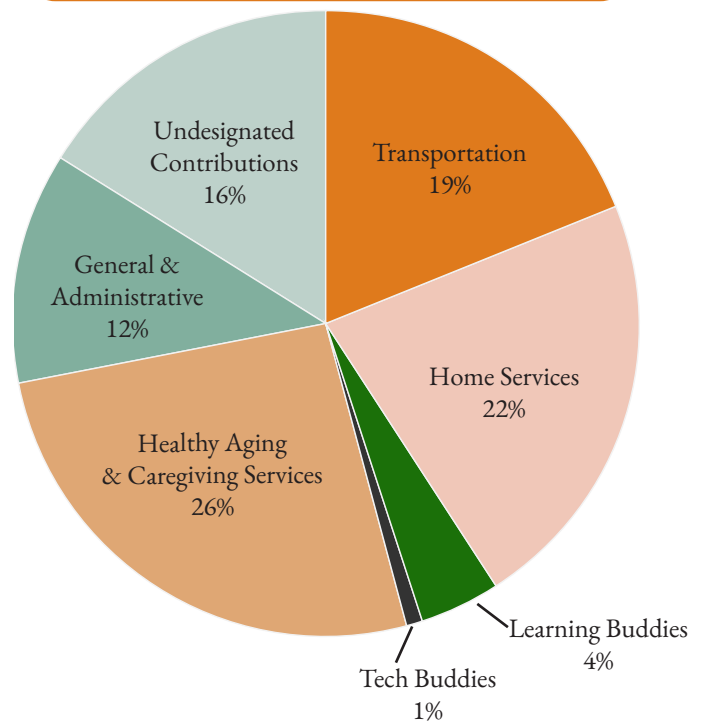

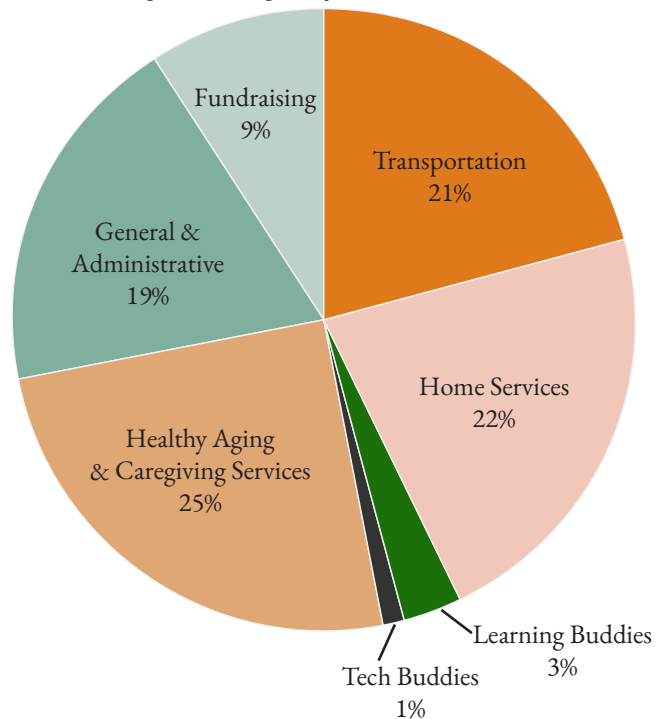

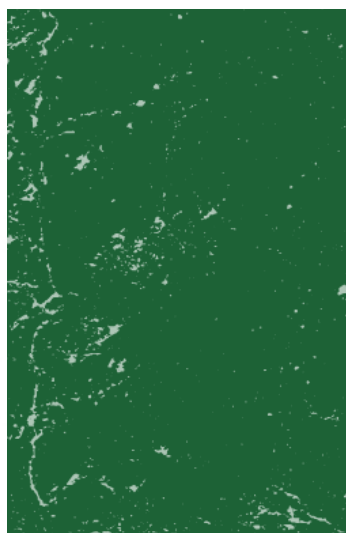
